



## EXTENDED UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS (EB)

On June 1, 2009 Senate Bill 810 became law authorizing the Agency for Workforce Innovation to begin paying Unemployment Compensation Extended Benefits (EB) to individuals who have exhausted all other state and federal unemployment benefits and meet eligibility requirements.

### **To Establish an Extended Benefits Claim and to Qualify for EB benefits, you must:**

- Have exhausted all regular and emergency unemployment compensation benefits after February 22, 2009 or have an eligible claim with a benefit year ending after February 22, 2009.
- Have no eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits in any state (including Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and The District of Columbia) or Canada.
