To file a formal written client complaint regarding the quality of service we have provided to you, or the decision not to accept your case, complete the Client Complaint Form and return it to the receptionist, or mail it to the Directing Attorney at the Main Office. Your complaint will be resolved within 20 days.

Clients who are age 60 and older, and whose representation is supported through Title III of the Older Americans Act, possess additional grievance rights provided for by the Alliance for Aging.
