## **How to get there?**

### **From Dade County**

Take a Bus to the Golden Glades station — A shuttle will be provided by Concept House. They will make trips from the Golden Glades Station departing hourly; trips start at 8 am and run until 2 pm. Return trips from the Armory to the Golden Glades Station, start hourly, from 9 am to 3 pm.

*Look for the “Keep Kids Drug Free” van.*

### **From Broward County**

There will be a shuttle van provided by Veterans Support Organization. It will make hourly rounds between the four locations listed below and the Armory. The shuttle will run from 8 am to 3 pm.

- Jubilee, 2020 Scott St. in Hollywood
- Main Bus Station in Downtown Ft. Lauderdale
- Cooperative Feeding, 1 NW 33rd Terrace Ft. Lauderdale
- Hollywood Blvd at Young Circle by Publix

## **WHAT TO BRING:**

Depending on what services you plan on receiving, you will need to bring a few things.

- For a Florida ID - you must bring:
  1. Birth Certificate or Passport
  2. Proof of Social Security Number (social security card, w-2, paystub, 1099)
  3. Two proofs of address (voter's registration card, w-2, 1099, mail from bank or government agency, certification of address with letter from a shelter, utility bill). If you have any questions, please call your closest Department of Motor Vehicles [DMV] or visit; <http://GatherGoGet.com/>
- Money for fees for DMV—approximately \$25
- Personal Documents, if needing assistance with claims or legal issues
- Resume (if seeking employment)
- Good attitude!

VA medical/dental screenings, Women Veterans, Social Work, Housing & Urban Development-VA Supported Housing, Grant & Per Diem, Mental Health, Vocational Rehab, Compensated Work Therapy, Suicide Prevention, Operation Enduring Freedom/Operation Iraqi Freedom and Outpatient Substance Abuse Clinic.

## **Non VA agency services:**

Haircuts, showers, shelter, food distribution, clothing, hygiene kits, benefits assistance, employment assistance and many others.
