## BECOMING A CLIENT

You may become a client of any of the Providers in a number of ways:

### Americans for Immigrant Justice (AI Justice)

#### *Formerly known as FIAC*

Call 305-573-1106 Monday thru Friday from 9AM to 12PM to be preliminarily screened for services. Appointments will be scheduled in appropriate cases. No Walk-ins. Attorneys on staff. No fees except application costs.

### American Friends Service Committee (AFSC)

Call 305-600-5441 to schedule an appointment to apply for services. Walk-ins are not encouraged. One Attorney. Free or low cost services.

### Catholic Charities Legal Services (CCLS)

Call 305-373-1073 to schedule an appointment or Walk-ins are welcome Monday through Friday 9AM to 3PM to apply for services. Several attorneys. Free or low cost services.

### Church World Service (CWS)

Call 305-774-6770 to schedule an appointment or Walk-ins are welcome on Tuesday or Thursday from 8am to 2pm to apply for services. Several attorneys. Free or low cost services.

### Colombian American Service Association (CASA)

Call 305-463-7468 to schedule an appointment or Walk-ins also welcome. Office Hours: Mon/Wed 9:00 AM- 6:00 PM;

Tues./Thurs. 10:00 AM- 8:00 PM; Fri. 8:30 AM-1:00 PM; Two (2) Saturdays a month by appointment only. One attorney. Free or low cost services (based on sliding scale)

### FIU College of Law/Carlos A. Costa Immigration and Human Rights Clinic (FIU)

Call 305-348-7541 to schedule an appointment. Cases accepted in early September and Mid-January only. One attorney supervises law students. No fees except application costs.

### International Rescue Committee (IRC)

Contact 305-640-9881 to schedule an appointment. Walk-ins also welcome. Serves primarily its own refugee, parolee, and asylee re-settlement clients. No attorneys. One Accredited Representative. Nominal fees.

### St. Thomas University Human Rights Institute (St Thomas HRI)

Call 1-866-491-6737 to schedule an appointment for services No Walk-ins. Several attorneys. No fees except application costs.

### St. Thomas University School of Law Immigration Clinic (St Thomas Immigration Clinic)

Call 305-623-2309 to schedule an appointment Walk-ins are not encouraged. Two full-time faculty supervise law students No fees except application costs.

### World Relief (WR)

Call 305-541-8320 to schedule an appointment or walk-in Monday through Friday. No attorney. Several Accredited Representatives. Low cost fees.

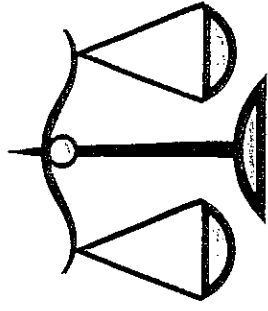
